Typical problems

- **Static descriptions**
 - the descriptions are not effective once they are needed
 - business change does not implement the activity descriptions
 - the descriptions not used to identify and manage issues and risks
- **Tools and techniques are too simple or complicated**
 - the overall picture created in the workshop is documented afterwards
 - capital investments are made but not used
- **Staff leave the company and take knowledge with them**
 - longer lead time to train the new employees
 - forcing you to maintain rather than develop

The solution

- **2c8 Modeling Tool**

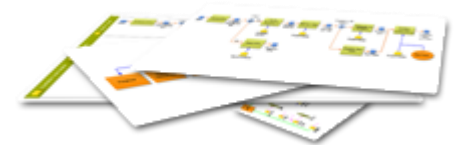
- so easy to work with that you can model live, with a projector in front of a workshop team

- the team feels a sense of pride over the result and automatically takes ownership

- **Models are saved as related objects into a database**

- relationships easy to find and manage
- easy to make reports
 - *for example: which activities are performed by a certain role*

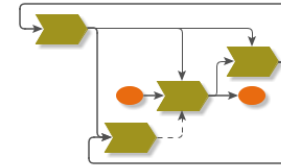

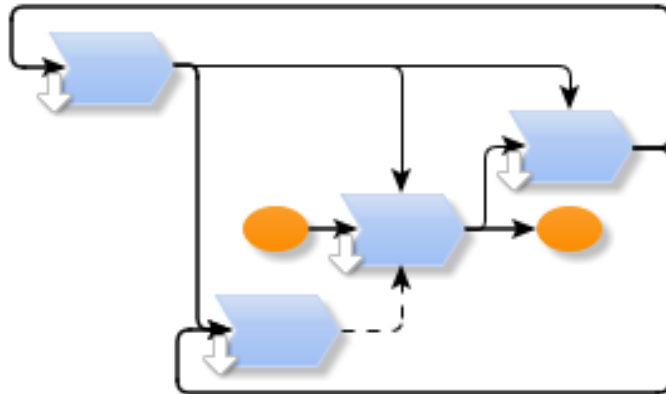

- **Flexible enough**

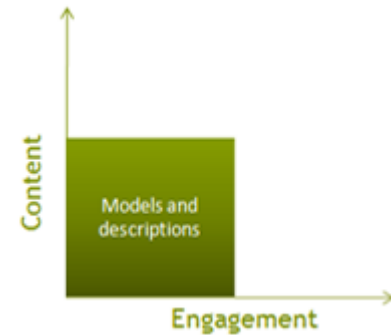
- to flow with the work

- only a matter of days before one can model live in front of a workshop group

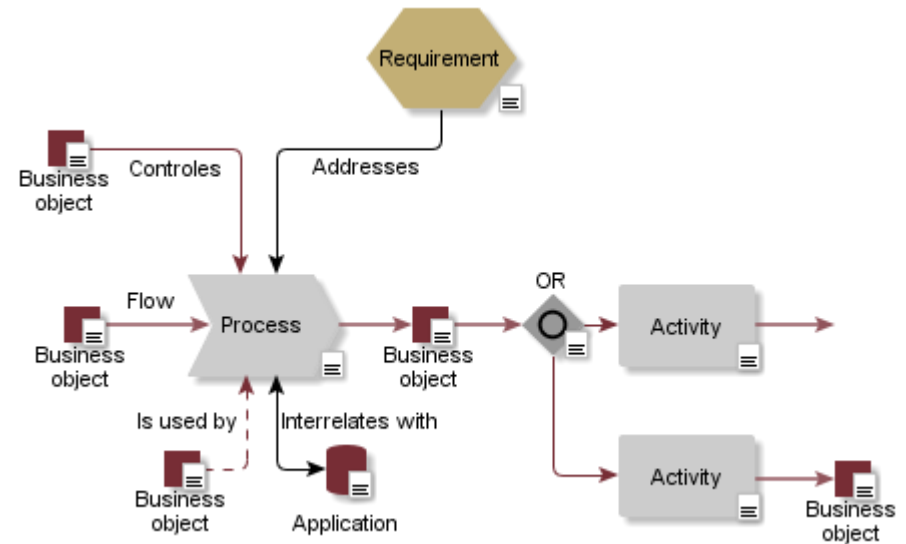
- **Fun and creative**

 - models are built from reusable objects

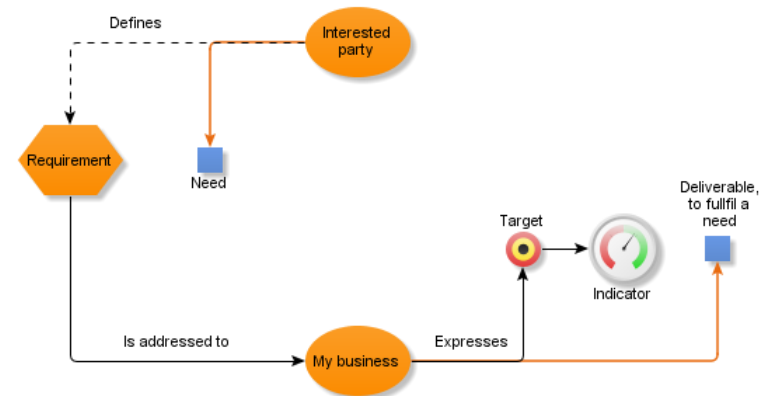
